Students bring specific requests from their regions, and we pray for various nations and situations around the world. We invite you to pray with us each week for these requests.

Today's Requests

For Students and Alumni

- Pray for those who minister in Muslim areas.
- Pray that the Lord would call more WAAST students and alumni to work among Muslims.
- Prav for the members of their families who are still in Islam.

From Students

• Benin: A girl and her parents who have become Christians have been physically affected by demonic forces. Recently the woman behind the attacks passed away. Another man is still actively attacking them. Please pray that he will see that the battle has been lost, and for this family.

• Mali: Pray concerning the political situation, which remains uncertain, and for the protection and witness of the churches and families there.

• Guinea-Conakry: Pray for those who accepted the Lord in an evangelistic campaign earlier this month. It can be easier to become a Christian than to remain a Christian

For Nations and People Groups*

• Pray for the 205 million Muslims of Indonesia. Pray that the Lord will strengthen the faith and witness of believers, and for favor with the government. Pray for a move of God among seeking Muslims.

• Pray for believers in Bangladesh. They are few and cannot worship openly. Pray that the Lord will give them creative wisdom to reach out to their families.

• Pray for the Hui people, scattered in the east, north-central, and northwest parts of China. This group is 100% Muslim, and speak Mandarin Chinese. A new Bible school on the Internet in the Mandarin language opens up new possibilities for reaching them. Pray for miracles among these people.

• Pray for Muslim youth across Europe. Some are leaving Islam but turning to secularism. Pray for European Christians, and especially the growing African churches in Europe, that they may reach them.

Looking Ahead: Requests for Friday 6 April*

• Pray for expatriate Christian workers in Saudi Arabia to gain opportunities to witness about Jesus. A large percentage of Saudi Arabia's population is made up of foreign workers.

• Pray for millions of Muslim families in Europe. Pray that the Gospel would reach the hearts of so many hungry people.
