## Extension Center News

**Cote d'Ivoire:** Coordinator Dr. Honoré Ouentchist reports that nine students attended the February/March session. The next session is in June/July. Seventeen candidates sat the entrance exam on 31 January. He asks us to pray for the smooth running of the center.

**Senegal:** Lord willing, six or seven students will come to Lomé in August—the first group to graduate from this center. The next session will be held 28 June–20 July. Please pray for the students, as several struggle with the academic level, and for financial provision, especially for those traveling to Lomé.

**Cameroon:** Thirty-three students are currently studying in this center, including one from Gabon and one from Chad.
