Students from 14 countries have descended on the Lomé campus. For the first time, all 8 extension centers have sent third-year students, and the Niger and Senegal centers will have their first graduates. Of the 131 students, 83 are working toward graduation in November. Along with the resident professors, 16 adjunct professors from 7

Extension Center News

Burkina Faso: Fifteen students are taking classes this session, with alumni Zachary Delma, Moïse Sawadogo, and Josué Dipama teaching. Nine are in Lomé to finish.

Cote d'Ivoire: The May/June session hosted 7 students. Alumni Daplex Ouentchist and Andre Kouadio taught. An extra session in October will make up a session lost last year. Three are now on the central campus working toward graduation.

Ghana: Sixty-seven students took courses in June/July, taught by alumni Phillip Arthur, Chris Dzoagbe, and Oppong Kyekyeku. Twenty + new students are expected in January. Twelve are preparing for graduation.

Senegal: Seven students attended the June/July session. Most complete their studies this year, and a new group will begin courses in February.

Sierra Leone: Thirteen students were in the June/July classes. Three are currently completing their program in Lomé. An entrance exam is slated for October.
