Today's Prayer Requests: *From Workers*

KENYA: Please pray for a new team now being established with the goal of training and sending out workers to Muslim people groups throughout the continent. Two leaders, a couple, are currently getting settled in the base city and ask us to pray for the following needs:

- Pray that the good relationship they have established with their Muslim landlord would continue, and that this family would come to know the Lord.
- Two families assigned to help lead and train are both facing serious challenges that are preventing their arrival in Kenya. “We feel this is an attack against these people and against this team that is slated to send out workers to all these people groups,” says a leader. Pray for God’s miraculous intervention and healing in these families.
- Pray for those who will be coming for training over the next few months. Pray for good relationships and great spiritual growth as together they study, minister, and prepare to go to their assigned areas of service.

SENEGAL: This past week, a team erected a church building for a congregation in Senegal’s far north, in an area dominated by staunch Muslim Wolofs and Pulaars. The team was composed of workers from Senegal, Burkina Faso, Côte d’Ivoire, Guinea Bissau, and the US—all of whom are serving the Church in Senegal. Please pray

- for the growth of this congregation in this very resistant area, and that the Lord would strengthen and mightily use the few members to reach their neighbors and families;
- that this building, strategically placed in the center of many villages, would attract people in the communities and become known as a haven for seekers;
- for God’s blessing on this pastor and workers from other countries as they minister in Senegal.

TOGO: Pray for God’s protection over pastors and believers in northern Togo, where sporadic jihadist attacks have become more frequent since 2022. According to the Global Terrorism Index 2025, there were 10 attacks in 2024, resulting in 52 deaths. Aside from the jihadist threat, workers in the Muslim-dominated north often face opposition from local residents. Pray that God would encourage and strengthen these workers, and that the Holy Spirit would open the eyes of the Muslims around them, that they may see Jesus.
